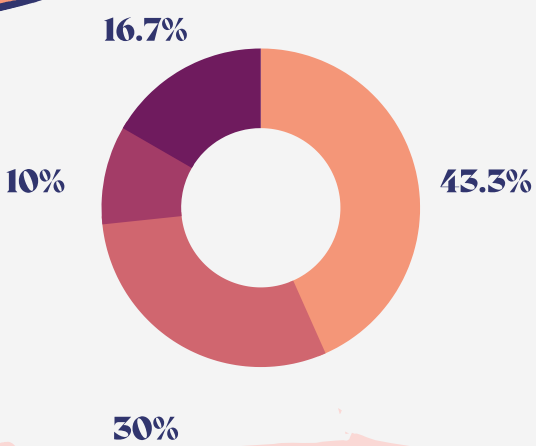
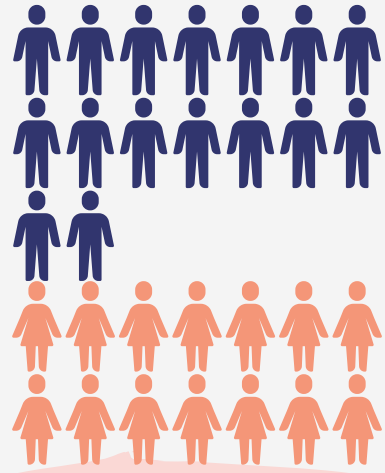


# IT'S ALL ABOUT THE Recycling of life

Recycling is the most basic way to protect the environment that is being advocated today. The following data is my sample of 30 surveys in SFU.

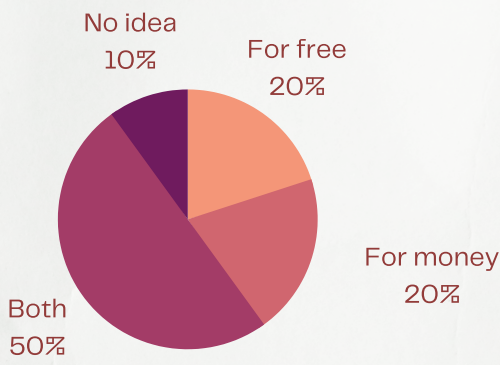
## 30 SURVEYS

This survey sampled 30 people in the SFU society. 16 of them were male and 14 were female.



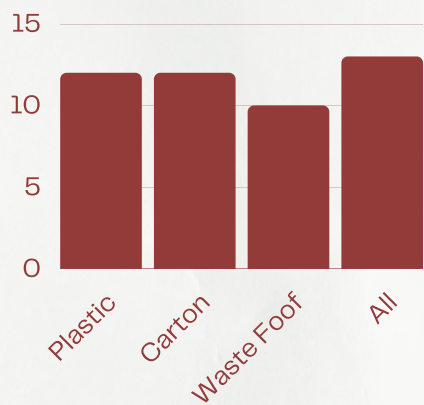
## 43.3%

What we're looking at is what motivates people to start recycling.



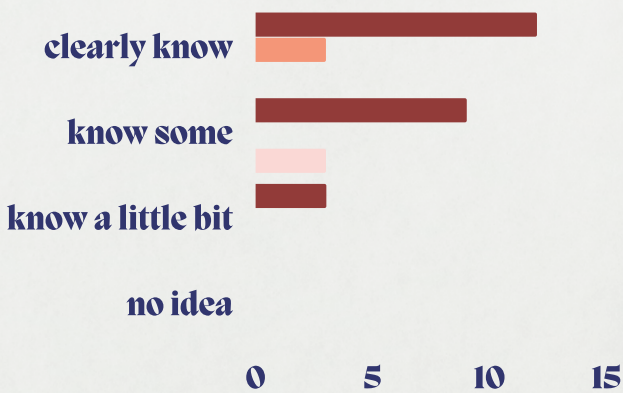
## What kind of recycling does your country do?
